If approved, this forbearance will end 180 days following completion of your qualifying military service.

A representative may complete and sign this form on your behalf if you are unable to do so (see Section 2b).

About the Service Member Civil Relief Act (SCRA)

The SCRA interest-rate cap is available for your private student loans. Interest on student loans obtained PRIOR to your active-duty military service is limited to 6% while on active duty. SCRA prohibits miscellaneous fees or charges to be imposed on your account during this period.

Application of benefit

We proactively check the U.S. Department of Defense's Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC) data base and automatically apply the benefit when applicable. **If you qualify for forbearance, we also apply SCRA benefits to your account simultaneously** and for the period you meet the criteria for qualifying military service.
